This interactive software allows for bi-directional "Real Time" transfer of data between the central office food service office programs, COMS-PRO and FAR-APPS Free & Reduced Application Processing and each campus site Point-Of-Sale System over the school districts wide-area network. COMS-PRO can effectively store, manage and distribute the information in "Real Time" and becomes the central point for creating, finding and sharing the information, as you need it.

Point Of Sale Programming

- Utilizes Large User Friendly Graphical Icon Buttons With Text Descriptions
- Allows for programming unlimited amount of menu item templates (Example: Type A Line, Ala Carte Line, Snack Bar, Etc.,) for each cafeterias POS terminals and transferring the menu types to the school site(s) POS system
- Menu item programming allows for programming the selling price and unit cost of 120 breakfast department keys (buttons), 120 lunch department keys (buttons) and 120 After school snack department keys (buttons)
- Allows for assigning individual menu types to specific POS Terminals within each cafeteria
- Allows for programming menu item (button) keys that make up a menu type
- Allows for programming the menu item keys (buttons) with the following data:

 equivalence factor parameters and transferring the settings to each school site(s) POS system
- Allows school enrollment figures and attendance factor, by school, to be entered by user or be automatically
 populated from the districts student enrollment import
- Allows free and reduced eligibility counts (number of students approved for meals by meal classification) to be
 manually entered, or if integrated with Free and Reduced software these fields are automatically populated. This
 data is used to compute the AccuClaim Edit Checks and is transferred to each school site(s) POS system in "Real
 Time"
- Allows for easy user entry and editing of state and federal reimbursement rates
- Allows for entering baseline percentages for Provision 2
- Allows for selecting qualifying severe needy schools

Master Student/Adult Account Database and Student Activity Reporting

- Maintain a Centralized student/adult account data base by school, containing the following information:
 - Name
 - Identification Number-(15 digits)
 - Food Service Identification Number (2-9 digits)
 - Meal Status (Free, Reduced, Regular, etc.)
 - Free & Reduced Application Number
 - Last Deposit On Account
 - Current Balance Of Account
 - Lost/Stolen Card Status
 - Meal Activity Participation (Breakfast, Lunch, or Ala Carte)
- Provides for automatically importing the districts student records database daily from the districts student information (enrollment) database to automatically build the "Global Master Centralized Student Meal Account Database".
- Provides the ability to exclude unused fields from the district enrollment import file

- Allows the free and reduced program to access and utilize the data in "Real Time" from the imported master student enrollment database
- Provides seamless integration for updating student meal account classifications, with application number, in the
 centralized meal account database from the data created in free and reduced software and transferring this data
 to the school sites POS system in "Real Time".
- Automatically produces a meal status change report for audit purposes when free and reduced updates are created in the centralized meal account database from a free and reduced program showing:
 - list of ID accounts that were changed (Updated)
 - list of ID accounts that were not found
 - list of ID accounts that were invalid
 - list of ID accounts that were created
- Allows for manually changing the meal status of a meal account and transferring (real time or batch process) the
 information to the school site(s) POS system if not integrated with a Free & Reduced program
- Automatically cross referencing the Free & Reduced software database when manually changing a meal account status to prevent changing a meal classification without having a Free & Reduced Application on file.
- Permits for easily creating a new student/adult account with name, primary I.D. number, secondary I.D. number, campus, grade, homeroom and family information
- Allows for printing individual bar coded ID cards
- Allows for printing bar coded ID card for all patron meal accounts
- Upon creation of a new meal account the account holders name, primary I.D. number, campus, grade, and homeroom is instantly available in the Free & Reduced software database.
- Provides for user defined restriction for Ala Carte purchases by individual account holder and have the restriction transferred to the appropriate school site POS system
- Provides a "Real Time Lookup " that allows patron meal accounts to be easily accessed by account number or account name and display the account holders balance at the time of the lookup over a wide-area network.
- Produces over a wide-area network in "Real Time" a individual detailed current "At the Instant" historical student/adult meal activity report of each menu item purchased, monies deposited to the account, by cash or check, with check number or by credit card, with credit card authorization number and balance on account with each transaction date and time stamped
- Creates on demand in "Real Time" instantly updated historical student/adult meal activity reports by date or over a date range.
- Allows for Patron Meal historical meal activity reports to be automatically transferred to a website to be accessed by guardians on line.
- Allows receiving prepayments for student/adult account holders by cash, check or credit cards at central food service office and instantly updating over a wide-area network in "Real Time" the student/adult accounts balances at the school sites.
- Provides for retrieving a student/adult account over a wide-area network and issuing refund to the account and having it posted "Instantly Real Time" to the account holder school site POS database.
- Allows for manual (or automatically from a daily district student enrollment import) transferring a student account
 with account balance from one school to another school.

- Provides for Global Account Access which allows any student/adult to eat any campus during the day.
- Allows for importing credit card meal payments made at <u>www.revtrak.com</u>
- Provides for transferring in "real time" patron meal account credit card payments to patron's meal accounts at each school site
- Automatically populates the family information fields in "Real Time" from the signature information contained in the free and reduced software
- Allows for manually associating family information to a student account holder with the following information:
 - Guardians name
 - Telephone number
 - Address
 - City, State and zip code

Patron Meal Account Reports

- Able to sort reports numerically or alphabetically on the name, ID number, balance on account, and meal classification fields
- Provides for viewing on screen or printing all the associated data with the student/adult account records
- Allows for viewing or printing administrative deposit report, showing the amount of prepay monies collected at the
 central food service office (with check numbers and credit card authorization number) and posted over a widearea network in "Real Time" to individual student/adult accounts at each school site(s) POS system.
- Allows for reporting of all meal account holders balances by individual campus
- Permits running reports with meal account holders with negative balances (charges) by school
- Allows for distributing credit collection letters to students or guardians that have negative balances
- Provides for e-mailing letters to students or guardians
- Permits running reports with account holders with low balances by school
- Letter editor that allows for user creation of collection or low cash letters
- Allows for reporting of all Non-Sufficient Funds checks by individual campus
- Allows for exporting the student account records database to other external databases or to spreadsheets
- Provides for user defined account holder filtering for reports by: regular, reduced, free, regular student worker, reduced student worker, free student worker, adult worker and adults
- Provides upon import of on-line patron meal credit card payments a report containing; Student name, Student ID, Amount, Transaction ID and Date/Time.

Labor Scheduling

• Central office reports are in the same format (mirror image) of the reports generated at school sites

 plate count from ala carte sales, total type A meals, total reimbursable meals, grand total all meals
- Reports have daily sales income by regular, reduced, free, adult, employee, contract, extra meals, adult ala carte, student ala carte, non-food item and sales tax
- Cash reconciliation report includes: total cash sales, deposits, total income, declared ending cash, over/short calculation
- Reports can be ran by campus or consolidated by all campuses, by date or date range
- Data entry screens to match the daily report format
- Allows for entering/editing school data (reports) at central office
- Produces a consolidated report of breakfast and lunch income for a total bank deposit
- Reports can be printed or viewed or produced by date or date range
- Automatically generates AccuClaim edits and participation reports by campus, by date or date range
- Allows for Provision 2 Reporting
